offered by MGM University for AY 2023-24 at MAHAGAMI GURUKUL Center for Performing Arts**

1. UG/PG Common Entrance Test (CETs) will be conducted for admission to UG/PG programs offered by MGM University, Aurangabad. MGMU-CET is to be planned as per following schedule:

3. Application for CET. Applications for the CET is being received online through the website of the university. CET/Registration fee is Rs. 1500/- which will be paid online on the university website

4. Details of the Programs and Applicable CETs. Names of the UG and PG programs, eligibility criteria and the CET/Registration applicable to take the admission in these programs are mentioned below in UG programs and PG programs respectively.

5. Conduct. The CETs will be conducted in the hybrid mode (online & offline mode) at Mahagami Gurukul, MGM Campus.

6. A candidate will be required to attempt MCQs and descriptive questions on the foundational concepts related to the subject in 90 minutes. There will be no negative marking.

7. Students will be given guidelines regarding reporting and login one day prior to the date of CET. Upto 10 minutes of late reporting will be permitted in unavoidable conditions.

8. Result of the CET will be declared after 2 days of conducting the test.

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
