

SCHOLARSHIP/FEE CONCESSION POLICY

Preamble:

1. The Mahatma Gandhi Mission Charitable Trust was established in the year 1982, to provide access to quality health services and institutes of higher learning with quality education to aspirants at affordable cost. Since its inception MGM Trust has been providing financial support to the needy students in terms of scholarships, freeships and other modes of financial support. The MGM Trust has set up its second University namely MGM University, Aurangabad as self-financed university established under Government of Maharashtra act No. XXVI of 2019. The university has become operational from 9th September, 2019. The university has been granted the status of 2(f) by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi under the category of State Private Universities.

2. In order to respect merit, irrespective of any other considerations, and to help the needy sections of the society, MGM University has formulated this scholarship policy to be implemented from the academic year 2020-2021 and these scholarships/freeships will be awarded per program.

Merit Scholarships:

3. There shall be four scholarships for meritorious students per program for all UG/PG programs to be conducted by MGMU provided that out of total selected students, 50% for girls and 50% for boys.

4. The first, second, third and fourth meritorious students in each program will be given 75%, 50%, 25% and 10% concession in Tuition Fee respectively for the first academic year only. The merit will be determined based on the score in the qualifying exam. Students will apply for the scholarships on the application form attached as Appendix I.

Sports/Athletics Merit Scholarship:

5. The University will award ten 'Sports' Merit' Scholarships to the students who have:
- a) Won state level award (1st to 3rd position) and have represented their state at national level in (amateur) competition and have written proof of the same.
 - b) Won national level award (1st to 3rd position) and have represented India at international level (amateur) and have written proof of the same.

- c) Such students should have participated in national/international level recognized event (by respective sports body) in the last two academic years only.
- d) This scholarship is open for Football, Basketball, Volleyball, Badminton, Rifle/pistol Shooting, Lawn Tennis, squash, Table Tennis, golf, Swimming, Kabaddi, Kho- Kho, wrestling, boxing, cycling or any track or field event of athletics.

6. Sports scholarship Award will be as under:

7. To award the sports scholarship, the academic performance of students should be valid for the last two years to consider the current year scholarship process and there will be no limits of the number of students.

Scholarships to the Wards of Martyrs:

8. Wards of defense forces personnel (Army, Navy, Air Force, Indian Coast Guard and NSG) ‘Killed in Action’ shall be provided 50 % Concession in the tuition fee in **all academic years.**

Hon’ble Chancellor’s Scholarships:

9. These scholarships are aimed at providing scholarships/financial support to needy and poor students. The students who have consistently maintained good academic performance and are socially and economically backward will be given concession in tuition fees entirely under the discretion of the Hon’ble Chancellor.

The percentage of scholarship to be awarded, number of students, annual income, academic performance etc. will be under the discretion of the Hon’ble Chancellor. The performance of students will be evaluated every year to qualify for the next year.

Scholarships to the wards of MGM employees

10. To award the scholarship for the wards of MGM employees, either the existing policy of MGM Trust will be followed or new policy of MGM University will be decided in due course of time. The number of students, annual income, essential criteria, academic performance percentage of scholarship etc. will be decided later on.

Alumni Scholarship:

11. The Alumni Association of MGM Institutions or an individual alumnus may institute a scholarship. Such scholarships will be offered to the students from financially weaker sections as and when available. The selection criteria will include financial need and consistency in academic performance or such conditions stipulated by the sponsoring association/persons.

Ph. D. Research Assistant Fellowship

12. There shall be Ph. D. Research Assistant Fellowship for the Ph. D. Research projects. A sum of Rs. 10,000/- each for two merit students within the entire MGM University will be awarded to the selected Ph. D. Research students. However, the final decision will be taken by the Scholarship Committee of MGM University.

Post Graduation Internship

13. There shall be Post Graduation Internship for the Post Graduation Projects. A sum of Rs. 8,000/- for first and Rs. 5,000/- for second merit students within the entire MGM University will be awarded to the selected students. However, the final decision will be taken by the Scholarship Committee of MGM University.

Scholarship/Freeship Committees:

14. There shall be institution/College wise Scholarship Committee formed under the chairpersonship of the Director/Principal/HOI's with two faculty members thereof. One Office-Superintendent/Accounts Officer will also be member of this committee. Every year this Scholarship Committee shall recommend the names of eligible candidates purely on the basis of rules to the Registrar. All cases of scholarships should be put up to the Hon'ble Chancellor for approval through proper channels through Registrar and Vice-Chancellor.

15. For Hon'ble Chancellor's Scholarship, name of eligible needy and meritorious students will be recommended to the Registrar and the Committee headed by the Registrar and all Deans as its members shall finalize the list of Hon'ble Chancellor's Scholarships awardees and get the list approved from the Hon'ble Chancellor.

16. The Scholarship Policy will be in effect from academic year 2020-2021.
