Ph.D. Entrance Test (PET)

Frequently Asked Questions

Q.1. Can a person who is not holding a relevant degree for admission in a PhD program still apply even though he / she will get the said certificate on a later date?

Answer. Yes, such persons can apply for the PET but they have to produce the original certificates on the day of interview by the DRC. Successful candidates will be interviewed by the DRC in the third week of June.

Q.2. Can one apply if he / she have valid teaching experience but have no relevant certificate?

Ans. Yes he/she can apply but may not be exempted from PET. For seeking exemption from PET read MGM University Ph.D. Ordinance O.7 available on this website. Moreover only 10 percent seats are available to the PET exempted candidates.

Q.3. Which all PhD programs are available in the MGM University.

Ans. Four faculties of MGM University are offering Ph.D. Programs. Disciplines and subjects for Ph.D. are mentioned on the 'Research Tab' of the website of the university.

Q. 4. Whom can I speak to if I want to discuss the topic of my Ph.D. research work?

Q. 5. How many vacant seats are available and the number of reserved seats.

Ans. Number of seats available for the Ph. D. program is given in the website. The university reserves the right to change the number depending on the number of guides / resources available at the time of admission. Forty percent seats are reserved for the candidates domiciled in the state of Maharashtra. Reservation policy of govt of Maharashtra will be followed for these seats. Sixty percent seats are open seats.

Q. 6. What is the syllabus of the PET exam.

Ans. Syllabus of UGC NET/SET where applicable will be the syllabus for the PET. In the subjects where NET/SET is not conducted, the university has uploaded the syllabus on the website.

Q. 7. Will I get any stipend / teaching position in the university?

Ans. There is no such provision as of now.

Q. 8. What are the conditions for exemption from the PET.

Ans. Please read MGM University Ph.D. Ordinance O.8. for details. Remember that only 10 percent seats will go those candidates who are exempted from the PET.

Q. 9. What are the important dates?

Ans. Important dates are:

- (a) Closing date for acceptance of applications by MGM University- 29 May 21, 11.00 pm.
- (b) Mock Test for PET. 01-03 Jun 21
- (c) Conduct of PET. 04 and 05 Jun 21 (Exact time will be given to you through e-mail)
- (d) Declaration of result of PET. 08 Jun 21
- (e) Interview by the DRC. 10 – 16 Jun 21
- (f) Tentative Date of Declaration of Final Merit List- 17 Jun 21
- (g) Tentative Dates of Admission to the Program – 18 Jun -23 Jun 21
